17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
18 OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
19 ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

21 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Amendment 50 to the Arkansas Constitution is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 2. Elections by ballot or voting machines authorized.

24 All elections by the people shall be by ballot or by voting machines
25 which insure the secrecy of all individual votes whether by ballot or by
26 voting machine.

28 SECTION 2. Section 3 of Amendment 50 to the Arkansas Constitution is
29 repealed.

30 ~~3. Numbering and recording of ballots—Disclosure of vote prohibited—~~

32 ~~In elections by ballot every ballot shall be numbered in the order in~~
33 ~~which it is received, the number shall be recorded by the election officers on~~

36 ~~elector voted unless required to do so as witnesses in a judicial proceeding~~
