20	WHEREAS, Mr. Ovid Switzer, Sr. of Crossett, Arkansas, died on Wednesday,
21	February 7, 2001, at the age of ninety-seven years; and
22	WHEREAS, Mr. Switzer was a graduate of Crossett High School and
23	Mississippi State College, and he practiced law in Crossett for more than
24	sixty years; and
25	WHEREAS, Mr. Switzer served in the Arkansas Senate from 1935-1938, and
26	served Ashley County as Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for twelve years; he was a
27	member of the Arkansas State Bar Association and past president of the Ashley
28	County Bar Association and the Southeast Arkansas Legal Institute; he was a
29	charter member and past president of the Crossett Riding Club, and a long time
30	member of First Baptist Church, Crossett Rotary Club and Prairie Country Club;

32	WHEREAS, Mr. Switzer served as Commissioner of the Arkansas Department
33	of Parks and Tourism under four governors, and in 1979 was designated
34	Commissioner Emeritus by the Arkansas Legislature; in 1982, he became the
35	first person to be inducted into the Arkansas Tourism Hall of Fame; and
36	WHEREAS, Mr. Switzer is survived by three sons, Ovid, Jr., Bruce, and

1	Phil, his long-time companion, Bettye Melton, eight grandchildren, two great-
2	grandchildren and one great-great grandchild; and
3	WHEREAS, the Senate of the Eighty-third General Assembly wishes to
4	publicly recognize Mr. Switzer's many contributions to the State of Arkansas
5	and to his local community,

7	NOW THEREFORE,
8	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
9	OF ARKANSAS:
