30	(a)(l) The State Board of Education shall be composed of twelve (12)
31	members. The terms of all members of the State Board of Education serving
32	one (1) day prior to the second Monday in January of 2004 shall expire on the
33	second Monday in January of 2004, and new members appointed under section
34	(a)(2) shall begin their terms on the second Monday in January of 2004.
