9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-101-304 TO
10 AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
11 ADMINISTRATION TO ISSUE A DUPLICATE OR SUBSTITUTE
12 CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER FOR MOTORBOATS IF THE
13 ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE IS LOST OR BECOMES
14 ILLEGIBLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-101-304(e), concerning the issuance of
26 certificates of number for registration of motorboats, is amended to read as
27 follows:

28 (e)(1) The certificate of number shall be pocket-sized and shall be
29 available at all times for inspection on the motorboat for which it is issued
30 whenever the motorboat is in operation.

31 (2)(A) If a certificate of number is lost, mutilated, or becomes
32 illegible, the owner of the motorboat for which the certificate was issued
33 shall immediately apply for, and may obtain, a duplicate or a substitute
34 certificate upon the applicant furnishing information satisfactory to the
35 department.

36 (B) If determined to be most advisable by the director, a

1 new registration under a new registration number may be issued.

2 (3) The application for a duplicate or substitute certificate or
3 a new registration to replace the original certificate of number shall be
4 accompanied by a fee of one dollar (\$1.00).
