24	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - MANSION EXPENSE. There is hereby appropriated,			
25	to the Arkansas Governor's Mansion Commission, to be payable from the State			
26	Central Services Fund, for Mansion Expenses for the Governor's Mansion for			
27	the Arkansas Governor's Mansion Commission which shall be supplemental and in			
28	addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 194 of 2001, the

36	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE W	TITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of	funds authorized	

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 3 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 9 10 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 19 20 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 21 the Arkansas Governor's Mansion Commission are, due to unforeseen 22 circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Governor's Mansion Commission to 23 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of 24 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas Governor's 25 Mansion Commission to continue such services; and that a delay in the 26 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper 27 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, 28 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the 29 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in 30 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 31 32 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 33 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 34

35 36 the veto.
