19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-418 (a) and (b) are amended to read as
22 follows:

23 *(a)(1) Early voting shall be available to any qualified elector who*
24 *applies to the county clerk clerk's during regular office hours designated*
25 *early voting location, beginning fifteen (15) days before ~~an~~ a primary, run-*
26 *off, or general election and ending on the day before election day at the*
27 *time the county clerk's office regularly closes between the hours of 8:00*
28 *a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.*
29 *Saturday, and ending at 6:00 p.m. on the Monday before the election.*

30 *(2) However, on all other elections, early voting shall be available*
31 *to any qualified elector who applies to the county clerk during regular*
32 *office hours, beginning fifteen (15) days before an election and ending on*
33 *the day before the election day at the time the county clerk's office*
34 *regularly closes.*

35 *(b)(1)(A) ~~In any county containing one hundred fifty thousand~~*
36 *~~(150,000) registered voters or more, the~~ The county board of election*

1 commissioners may decide to hold early voting at additional polling sites
2 outside the offices of the county clerk and to include the additional voting
3 *locations for a maximum of fifteen (15) days ~~but fewer if it so chooses by a~~*

6 (B) The county board shall determine by unanimous vote the
7 location of additional polling sites for early voting.

8 (C) The county clerk shall publish the location of
9 additional early voting polling sites in a newspaper of general circulation
10 at least five (5) days before early voting begins.

11 (2) The county board shall select the number of election
12 officials necessary to adequately staff the additional early voting polling
13 site or sites as in any other election.

14 (3)(A) The county board shall notify the county clerk of its
15 decision to hold early voting at additional polling sites outside the office
16 of the county clerk within ten (10) days of the decision.

17 (B) If the county board decides to hold early voting at
18 additional polling sites outside the office of county clerk, the county clerk
19 may choose not to hold early voting within the office of the county clerk.
20 The county clerk shall notify the county board within ten (10) days of the
21 receipt of notice from the county board regarding early voting at additional
22 polling sites.

23 (4) The early voting election official shall record the date on
24 all pages of the early voting roster or early voting request form and keep a
25 daily record of the number of early ballots cast.

26 ~~(5)(A) The county board may vote to extend the normal hours for~~
27 ~~voting during early voting.~~

28 ~~(B)~~ The county clerk shall publish the additional hours
29 for early voting with the location of additional early voting polling sites
30 in a newspaper of general circulation at least five (5) days before early
31 voting begins.
