        (a) All fees collected on behalf of the State Board of Cosmetology and

     all receipts of every kind and nature shall be paid into the State Treasury

     and shall be credited to the Cosmetology Contingent Operating Fund. The

     Cosmetology Contingent Operating Fund shall be for the general uses of the

     board and out of it shall be paid all salaries and all other expenses

     necessarily incurred in carrying into effect the provisions of this chapter.

     TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act the Chief Fiscal
     Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State

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- 1 Treasurer and Auditor of State the unexpended balance of monies remaining in
- 2 <u>the Cosmetology Board Construction Fund to the Cosmetology Operating Fund</u>

- 9 19-6-414. Cosmetology Board Construction Fund.
- 10 The Cosmetology Board Construction Fund shall consist of the unexpended
- 11 balances in the fund on June 30, 1991, there to be used for the construction
- 12 or purchase of facilities for the use of the board and for temporary loans to
- 13 the Cosmetology Contingent Fund as authorized by law and for such other
- 14 purposes as may be authorized by law.

- 16 SECTION 10. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
- 17 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES COSMETOLOGY
- 18 OPERATING FUND. (A) For all appropriations as provided in this Act, the
- 19 agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund balances in
- 20 relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures
- 21 would cause the Cosmetology Operating Fund to decline below One Hundred
- 22 Ninety Seven Thousand One Hundred Nine Dollars (\$197,109) a fund balance to
- 23 decline to less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1,
- 24 2001, the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of
- 25 the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances,
- 26 the agency head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal
- 27 Officer of the State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such
- 28 documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to justify the
- 29 expenditures and shall include the following:
- 30 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 31 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 32 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut
- 33 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 34 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs

- 35 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 36 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not

- 1 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 2 depletion of the fund balance.
- 3 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 4 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
- 5 prior review by the Legislative Council.
- 6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
- 7 through June 30, 2005.

- 9 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 10 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 11 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 12 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 19 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 28 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
- 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 34 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
- 35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
- 36 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
