5	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
6	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the benefits for members of
7	the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System are inadequate; that the
8	benefits should be increased to continue to motivate the emergency service
9	employees of our local governments; that the most beneficial time to increase
10	the benefits is during the beginning of the state fiscal year; and this act
