## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PERMIT DISABLED VETERANS PARKING  
PRIVILEGES IN THOSE AREAS DESIGNATED FOR PARKING  
ONLY BY PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PERMIT DISABLED VETERANS PARKING  
PRIVILEGES IN THOSE AREAS DESIGNATED FOR  
PARKING ONLY BY PERSONS WITH  
DISABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. A vehicle displaying a special "disabled veteran" license plate issued to a totally and permanently disabled service-connected veteran under Arkansas Code § 27-15-403, or a valid "disabled veteran" license plate issued by another state, and being used for the actual transporting of a disabled veteran, is permitted parking privileges in those areas designated for parking only by persons with disabilities under the "Access to Parking for Persons with Disabilities Act", Arkansas Code §§ 27-15-301 et seq.
