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SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 35 CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the restructuring of the

- 1 Technical Institutes, Great Rivers Technical Institute shall establish and
- 2 maintain for the $\frac{2001-2003}{2003-2005}$ biennium a pool of two (2) four (4)
- 3 unclassified positions and one (1) three (3) classified positions, payable
- 4 from funds appropriated for Great Rivers Technical Institute. These
- 5 positions are to be used by Great Rivers Technical Institute in the event
- 6 that the number and level of positions available to address the needs
- 7 emerging from business and industry driven program expansions exceeds the
- 8 number of positions regularly authorized for Great Rivers Technical
- 9 Institute.
- 10 (b) Great Rivers Technical Institute shall provide justification to the
- 11 Department of Finance and Administration's Office of Personnel Management
- 12 (OPM) for the need to allocate titles from this position pool. No
- 13 classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific
- 14 positions are requested and justified by Great Rivers Technical Institute,
- 15 recommended by OPM and approved by the Legislative Council. Great Rivers
- 16 Technical Institute may transfer positions from this pool to any pay schedule
- 17 the agency currently maintains or any pay schedule the agency receives during
- 18 the $\frac{2001-2003}{2003-2005}$ biennium.
- 19 (c) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is
- 20 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
- 21 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the
- 22 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has
- 23 determined that Great Rivers Technical Institute could be operated more
- 24 efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is
- 25 being accomplished by providing growth pools in subsection (a) of this
- 26 section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers
- 27 under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the
- 28 General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by
- 29 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the
- 30 growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative
- 31 Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of
- 32 approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court
- 33 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- 34 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
- 35 established herein during the next biennium, the position(s) must be
- 36 requested as a new position(s) in the agencies biennial budget request.

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4 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PART-TIME
- 6 FACULTY. The Technical Institutes are not required to remit a state
- 7 contribution to the state employee insurance trust fund on Workforce
- 8 Education Part-time Faculty Positions unless the position will be utilized
- 9 for more than 1,000 hours a year.
- 10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
- 11 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

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- 13 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 16 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

- 35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
- 36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

2	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the

6	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
