SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. 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- SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 17 CODE NOR TOURISHED DEFARABLES AS STEETER, BOOKE AND TEST CHART DAW.
- 19 Technical Institutes, Forest Echoes Technical Institute shall establish and
- 20 maintain for the 2001-2003 2003-2005 biennium a pool of four (4) unclassified

CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the restructuring of the

- 21 positions and three (3) classified positions, payable from funds appropriated
- 22 for Forest Echoes Technical Institute. These positions are to be used by
- 23 Forest Echoes Technical Institute in the event that the number and level of
- 24 positions available to address the needs emerging from business and industry
- 25 driven program expansions exceeds the number of positions regularly
- 26 authorized for Forest Echoes Technical Institute.
- 27 (b) Forest Echoes Technical Institute shall provide justification to the
- 28 Department of Finance and Administration's Office of Personnel Management
- 29 (OPM) for the need to allocate titles from this position pool. No
- 30 classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific
- 31 positions are requested and justified by Forest Echoes Technical Institute,
- 32 recommended by OPM and approved by the Legislative Council. Forest Echoes
- 33 Technical Institute may transfer positions from this pool to any pay schedule
- 34 the agency currently maintains or any pay schedule the agency receives during
- 35 the $\frac{2001-2003}{2003-2005}$ biennium.
- 36 (c) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is

- 1 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
- 2 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the
- 3 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has
- 4 determined that Forest Echoes Technical Institute could be operated more
- 5 efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is
- 6 being accomplished by providing growth pools in subsection (a) of this
- 7 section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers
- 8 under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the
- 9 General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by
- 10 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the
- 11 growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative
- 12 Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of
- 13 approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court
- 14 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- 15 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
- 16 established herein during the next biennium, the position(s) must be
- 17 requested as a new position(s) in the agencies biennial budget request.
- 18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July
- 19 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

- 21 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PART-TIME
- 23 FACULTY. The Technical Institutes are not required to remit a state
- 24 contribution to the state employee insurance trust fund on Workforce
- 25 Education Part-time Faculty Positions unless the position will be utilized
- 26 for more than 1,000 hours a year.
- 27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
- 28 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

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- 30 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 33 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
3	
4	SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
12	
13	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
16	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
17	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
20	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
