The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation 11 Department is authorized to pay from Item (3) of Section 2 hereof, the 12 Unemployment Premiums and Workers Compensation Premiums, at a rate not in 13 excess of the Agency's experience rate, under the provisions of regulations 14 established by the Department of Finance and Administration. 15 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 17 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 18 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 19 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING 21 REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to take 22 appropriate action as necessary to restrict or reduce the operating, 23 administration, and other associated costs of the State Highway and Transportation Department, including the Arkansas Highway Police Division, 24 25 for the biennial period ending June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. Provided 26 further, that the Arkansas Highway Commission is directed to furnish the 27 Arkansas Legislative Council with an expenditure status report regarding the 28 financial activities of the State Highway and Transportation Department at 29 least quarterly, beginning no later than September 30, 1989. 30 31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 32 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 33 SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 34 35 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 36 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

8 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

17 SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 18 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 19 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 22 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 23 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 24 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 25 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 26 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 27 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 28 29 30 31 32 33

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
