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- 2 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 4 CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the restructuring of the
- 5 Technical Institutes, Arkansas Valley Technical Institute shall establish and
- 6 maintain for the 2001-2003 2003-2005 biennium a pool of four (4) unclassified
- 7 positions and three (3) classified positions, payable from funds appropriated
- 8 for Arkansas Valley Technical Institute. These positions are to be used by
- 9 Arkansas Valley Technical Institute in the event that the number and level of
- 10 positions available to address the needs emerging from business and industry
- 11 driven program expansions exceeds the number of positions regularly
- 12 authorized for Arkansas Valley Technical Institute.

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PART-TIME 9 FACULTY. The Technical Institutes are not required to remit a state contribution to the state employee insurance trust fund on Workforce 10 11 Education Part-time Faculty Positions unless the position will be utilized 12 for more than 1,000 hours a year. 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 14 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 15 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HEALTH 17 INSURANCE. By November 30, 2003, employees who were employed on June 30, 18 2003 by Arkansas Valley Technical Institute shall have the right to make a 19 20 one-time choice between: 21 The Arkansas Tech University Health Insurance Plan; or (i) 22 (ii) The health insurance plan adopted by the state and Public school 23 life and Health Insurance Board for state employees. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 24 25 through June 30, 2005. 26 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 27 28 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 29 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 30 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 31 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

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strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1	SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
2	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
3	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
4	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
5	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
6	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
7	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
8	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
9	
10	SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
16	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
17	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
18	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
19	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
20	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
