6 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA 8 SALARIES. There is hereby authorized for the Department of Workforce 9 Education - Rehabilitation Services for the 2001-03 2003-05 biennium the 10 following increases in salaries for certain positions provided in the regular 11 salary schedule of the Department of Workforce Education - Rehabilitation 12 Services and to be in addition to the annual amounts as established by the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, as amended: for full time 13 14 physicians certified by the American Specialty Boards a rate of pay not to 15 exceed an additional \$4,500 per year; for each full time physician eligible 16 to be certified by the American Specialty Boards a rate of pay not to exceed 17 \$2,500 per year with the total not to exceed \$7,000. In the event the physician is not a full-time employee, the amount specified herein shall be 18 19 adjusted proportionately to the amount of time worked for the Department of Workforce Education - Rehabilitation Services by that physician. 20

SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 24 25 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 26 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 27 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 29 30 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 31 32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

34 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 36 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

11	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
14	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
