SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5)

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1 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed

2 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its

3 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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5 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby

6 appropriated, to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be payable

7 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas

Development Finance Authority, for personal services and operating expenses

of the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the biennial period ending

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SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized in Item (07) of Section 2 of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002 June 30, 2004 shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

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1 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUD HOME PROGRAM DISBURSEMENTS. The disbursement of funds appropriated in Item (07) of 3 4 Section 2 of this Act shall be in accordance with the State of Arkansas 5 Consolidated Plan Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy developed and 6 administered in part by the Arkansas Development Finance Authority and shall 7 be in accordance with project requirements and regulations of the U.S. 8 Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Program. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 10 11 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING 14 REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall report 15 quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative Council the total expenditures in the 16 Arkansas Home Equity Loan Program, Farmer MAC Guaranteed Loan Program, and 17 Agricultural Loan Mediation and Development Program. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July 1, 2003 through June 18 19 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 20 21 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 24 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 30 31 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations

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and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

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1	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
2	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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4	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
6	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
7	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
8	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
10	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
11	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
12	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
13	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
14	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
