22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-1602(a), concerning payroll deductions
25 for state employees, is amended to read as follows:

26 (a) Deductions from the payrolls of state employees, both regular and
27 extra help, shall be permitted only for the following purposes:

28 (1) Withholding taxes;


29 (2) Social security contributions;

30 (3) Contributions to any state retirement system or approved
31 plan of deferred compensation;

32 (4) Group hospital, medical, and life insurance deductions.

33 However, any payroll deductions through the Arkansas state mechanized payroll
34 system for state employees for coverages other than the state-authorized plan
35 shall be approved by the State and Public School Life Insurance Board;

36 (5) Payments to state employees' credit unions;

- 2 (7) Payment of union dues, when requested in writing by state

- 4 (8) Purchase of United States Government savings bonds;
- 5 (9) Arkansas State Employees' Association, Inc., dues, when

- 8 Corporation, when requested in writing by those state employees;
- 9 (11) Contributions to the major federated fund-raising
- 10 organization, when authorized by those state employees;
- 11 (12) Arkansas State Police Association dues, when authorized in
- 12 writing by those state employees;
- 13 (13) Fraternal Order of Police dues, when requested in writing
- 14 by those state employees;
- 15 (14) Central Arkansas State Troopers Coalition dues, when
- 16 authorized in writing by those state employees;
- 17 (15) Arkansas Rehabilitation Association dues, when authorized
- 18 in writing by those state employees;
- 19 (16) Correction Peace Officers Foundation dues, when authorized
- 20 in writing by those state employees;
- 21 (17) Arkansas Department of Correction employee association
- 22 dues, when requested in writing by those employees; ~~and~~
- 23 (18) Payment of premiums for prepaid legal insurance, when
- 24 requested in writing by those state employees; and
- 25 ~~(18)~~(19) For such other purposes as are specifically authorized
- 26 by law but not enumerated in this subsection.
