Each state agency, whose annual income or revenue as 14 reflected by the previous fiscal year's audit exceeds twenty-five thousand 15 dollars (\$25,000), shall remit by check on the first day of each calendar 16 quarter to the Treasurer of State an amount equal to one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) of the total expenditures of the previous calendar guarter from 17 18 those cash funds as defined under § 19-4-801, excluding funds received from 19 the federal government or those held in trust by the state agency or those 20 funds of the various state retirement systems. Funds received by the 21 Department of Arkansas Heritage from voluntary donations and/or non-federal 22 grants shall also be excluded.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

26 SECTION 31. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PROMOTIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS. The Department of Arkansas Heritage is 28 29 hereby authorized to purchase from Maintenance and General Operations 30 appropriations provided by this Act, up to an amount not to exceed \$25,000 31 each fiscal year, promotional and educational merchandise, authorized by the 32 Director of the Department, to inform the public of the Department's 33 programs, to promote the functions of the Department, and to inform the public regarding the services provided by the Department. 34 35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001

1 2 SECTION 32. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. NATURAL 4 AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL. The Director of the Department of Arkansas Heritage shall be the disbursing officer for the Natural and Cultural 5 6 Resources Council appropriation and the Main Street Program appropriation provided by this Act. Further, if grants are made to state agencies from the 7 8 Natural and Cultural Resources Council appropriation, and the Main Street 9 Program appropriation provided herein, the corresponding amount of 10 appropriation and funding of such grant may be transferred to such state 11 agency for use in classifications of expenditures as determined by conditions 12 of the grant and the state agency. 13 In the event that such grants make it necessary to employ additional 14 personnel, the Department of Arkansas Heritage upon seeking prior review of 15 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee and approval of 16 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, may establish one or more new 17 additional positions at classifications and grades in conformance with the 18 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (A.C.A. 22-5-201 et seq), but in 19 no event shall the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State authorize the 20 establishment of more than seven (7) regular new additional positions. The 21 Chief Fiscal Officer shall certify to the State Auditor and the State 22 Treasurer such approval of additional positions. 23 The unexpended balance of the Natural and Cultural Resources Council appropriation provided herein, for grants made to state agencies for the 24 25 acquisition, management, stewardship and preservation of state-owned lands or 26 historic sites, which remain on June 30, 2002 June 30, 2004, shall be carried 27 forward and made available for the same purposes for the fiscal year ending 28 June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 32 SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 34 PUBLICATION DEVELOPMENT AND RESALE. The Department of Arkansas Heritage is 35 hereby authorized to make fund transfers from the Natural & Cultural 36 Resources Historic Preservation Fund or other funds established from federal

or non-federal grants to the Publication Development and Resale Revolving
Fund to use to develop and purchase additional publications for resale after
seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council. In no case shall
the fund transfers exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) in any

9 SECTION 34. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 10 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 11 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 12 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

19 SECTION 35. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28 SECTION 36. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of

- 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 34 <u>date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the</u>

35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

36 <u>Therefore</u>, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

1	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
2	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
