In cities with a city manager form of government and with civil service commissions, the civil service commission shall have the power to override the city manager's appointment or removal of the police or fire chief by a majority vote of the total membership of the commission. (c)(1) The provisions of this section shall not apply to department heads not under the control of the governing body of the city and shall not apply to cities having a city administrator form of government. (2) However, the provisions of this section shall apply to the heads of the police and fire departments in a city with a civil service commission. SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-51-102 is amended to read as follows: 14-51-102. Applicability. (a) In addition to all other powers possessed by cities of the first class, these cities may establish a board of civil service commissioners for the police and fire departments of their cities. (b) However, the provisions of this chapter shall not apply to the appointment or removal of the heads of the police and fire departments in a city that establishes a civil service commission under this chapter.
