SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 24 SCIENCE 25 AND MATH EQUIPMENT. The funds appropriated in this Act for Math & Science 26 Equipment shall be allocated in accordance with regulations and procedures 27 promulgated by the Department of Education - General Education Division with 28 priority given to those school districts demonstrating the greatest need. 29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 30 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

32 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TURNBACK 34 FUNDS. Any Federal Mineral Leasing Funds, Federal Forest Reserve Funds, 35 Federal Flood Control Funds, or any similar turnback funds in the State 36 Treasury for which the eligible county and/or school district cannot be

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1 identified may be transferred to the Department of Education Public School 2 Fund Account and used for any lawful school purpose. 3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 4 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 5 6 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YEAR-END 8 FUND BALANCE. Notwithstanding any law pertaining to the transfer of year-end fund balances or any law to the contrary, any funds which remain in the 9 10 Department of Education Fund Account at the end of a fiscal year shall remain 11 in the Department of Education Fund Account and made available to fund 12 appropriation authorized by law and made payable from the Department of Education Fund Account for the following fiscal year. 13 14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 15 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 16 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 18 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act the Chief Fiscal 19 Officer of the State shall transfer on his books, and those of the State 20 Treasurer and Auditor of State, the balance of monies remaining in the 21 22 Educational Loan Fund to the Education Revolving Loan Certificates Fund. 23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 24 through June 30, 2005. 25 26 SECTION 22. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES - PUBLIC 27 ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL INSURANCE FUND. (A) For all appropriations 28 29 as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the 30 level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause the Public Elementary and Secondary 31 32 School Insurance Fund to decline below two million eight hundred fifty two 33 thousand eight hundred thirty two dollars (\$2,852,832) a fund balance to 34 decline to less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 35 2001, the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of 36 the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances,

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1 the agency head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal 2 Officer of the State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to justify the 3 4 expenditures and shall include the following: 5 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such 6 expenditures on the fund balance. 7 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut 8 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 9 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs 10 or one-time purchase of capitalized items. 11 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not 12 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent depletion of the fund balance. 13 (B) 14 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and 15 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought 16 prior review by the Legislative Council. 17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2005. 18 19

20 SECTION 23. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 21 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 22 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 23 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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30 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 31 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 32 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 33 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 34 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 36 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

1	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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3	SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
5	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
9	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
10	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
11	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
12	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
13	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
