16	Commissioned employees who are hired as State Police Troopers will be
17	considered Recruits within the grade 19 classification and shall remain at
18	Pay Level I until the successful completion of recruit school. These

20	employment and shall be eligible for a salary adjustment not to exceed a rate
21	that is equal to fifty percent (50%) of the range between Pay Level 1 and Pay
22	Level II of grade 19. After satisfactory completion of 12 months of
23	employment as a Trainee, the Trainee will become eligible for promotion to
24	State Police Trooper and shall be eligible for salary adjustments up to Pay
25	Level II of the grade 19.

27	After completion of four and a half years of employment the Commissioned
28	employee will be eligible for promotion to Trooper First Class, grade 20.
29	After seven and a half years of employment, the employee will be eligible for
30	promotion to Corporal, grade 21. Employees will be eligible for normal
31	promotion increases as they advance to the classifications of Sergeant,
32	Lieutenant, Captain, and Major. Any disciplinary actions taken against an
33	employee may delay the promotional process.
34	
35	Current employees shall be eligible for equity adjustments of up to 3% as
36	deemed necessary by the Arkansas State Police. Applications for these

14	(a) In addition to the salaries authorized in this section, the officers,
15	patrolmen, and other employees of the Department of Arkansas State Police
16	shall be entitled to and receive actual expenses incurred by them when on
17	duty away from home.
18	(b)(1)(A) The amounts payable for uniform allowance shall not exceed one
19	thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) per annum for each state police
20	colonel, lieutenant colonel, major, captain, lieutenant, sergeant, corporal,
21	trooper first class, drug diversion manager, drug diversion investigator, and
22	trooper.
23	(ii) However, each department in his or her first year of service may
24	receive up to, but not to exceed, two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for uniform

drug diversion investigator.

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SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 3 4 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 5 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 6 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 10 11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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13 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 14 15 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 16 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 17 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 18 19 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 20 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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22 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 24 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 25 26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 27 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 28 29 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 30 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 31 32 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 33 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 34 35
