There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas 34 Public Employees Retirement System for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following 35 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra 36 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four (4)

SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 10 11 TRANSFERS. A sum not to exceed \$31,935 \$34,538 in the 2001-2002 2003-2004 fiscal year, and \$32,893 \$36,265 in the 2002-2003 2004-2005 fiscal year may 12 be transferred from the State Police Retirement Fund to the Arkansas Public 13 14 Employees Retirement System Fund for costs incurred by the Arkansas Public 15 Employees Retirement System in administering the State Police Retirement 16 System. 22 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE, NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. A sum not 23 24 to exceed \$59,269 in the 2003-2004 fiscal year, and \$126,003 in the 2004-2005 fiscal year may be transferred from the District Judges Retirement Fund to 25 26 the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System Fund for costs incurred by 27 the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System in administering the District 28 Judge Retirement Fund. Such transfer request shall be made to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and upon his approval, said transfer shall be 29 30 made on his books and those of the Treasurer of the State and the Auditor of 31 the State. 32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 33 through June 30, 2005. 34

35 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

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made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 20 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 24 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 25 26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 28 29 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 30 31 32 33 34
