- 16 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December
- 17 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or
- 18 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during
- 19 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
- 20 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
- 21 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon
- 22 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
- 23 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
- 24 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.
- 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
- 26 through June 30, 2005.

- 28 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 29 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 30 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 31 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
- 34 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
- 35 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
- 36 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

1	with in disbursement of said funds.
2	
3	SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
4	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
5	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
6	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
7	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
9	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
10	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
11	
12	SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
16	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
18	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
19	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
20	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
21	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
