There is hereby authorized, for the 18 19 University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the 2003-2005 biennium, the 20 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as 21 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one 22 thousand three hundred thirty (1,330) temporary or part-time employees, when 23 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform 24 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the 25 appropriate classification.

27 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, 28 to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, to be payable from the 29 University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund, for personal services and 30 operating expenses of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the 31 biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

2 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 3 4 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing 5 and other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of the athletic director, 6 assistant athletic directors, head basketball coaches, and assistant coaches 7 at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the Board of Trustees may make 8 special allowances available therefor in such amounts as the Board of 9 Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the 10 unusual and exacting duties of said athletic director, assistant athletic 11 directors, head basketball coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the 12 purpose of providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas at Little 13 14 Rock, which is derived from athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed 15 twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during 16 each year of the 2001-2003 2003-2005 biennium for the athletic director and 17 head basketball coaches, and ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during the 2001-2003 2003-2005 biennium for the assistant 18 19 athletic directors and assistant coaches. Provided that any such allowances shall be in addition to the regular salary of such athletic director, 20 21 assistant athletic directors, head basketball coaches and assistant coaches, 22 as established herein provided that the amount of such allowance shall not 23 exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum for any one salaried 24 position. Further, if the special allowance funds authorized herein are 25 utilized the University of Arkansas at Little Rock shall report annually to 26 the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of the those 27 special allowances funds authorized herein.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001

31 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 33 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 34 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 35 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 36 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December

1 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 2 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 3 4 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the 5 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 6 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal 7 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board 8 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 10 through June 30, 2005.

12 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 13 14 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 15 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 18 19 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 20 21 with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 23 24 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 25 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 26 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 27 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 30 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

32 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

33 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

34 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the

35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of

36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
2	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
3	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
4	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
5	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
6	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
