27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 18-28-202(a), concerning presumptions of
28	property abandonment under the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act,
29	is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
30	(15) Unclaimed property payable or distributable in the course of a
31	demutualization of an insurance company, five (5) years after the earlier of:
32	(A) The date of last contact with the policy holder; or
33	(B) The date the property became payable or distributable.

35	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 18-28-207(d), concerning reports of
36	abandoned property under the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act,

(d) The report must be filed before November 1 of each year and cover
the twelve (12) months next preceding July 1 of that year, but a report with
respect to a life insurance company, including the report and remittance of
<u>unclaimed insurance company demutualization proceeds made under § 18-28-</u>
<u>202(a)(15)</u>, must be filed before May 1 of each year for the calendar year
next preceding.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that under the current provisions
of the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act, there is no specific
provision addressing unclaimed property distributed as a result of the
demutualization of an insurance company; that this act is immediately
necessary because it will facilitate the collection of that property during
fiscal year 2003 by expanding the scope of insurance companies required to
file unclaimed property reports on May 1, 2003. Therefore, an emergency is
declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
<u>on:</u>
(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
bill; or
(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.

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
