It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 20 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 23 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 24 25 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 28 29 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 30 31 32 33 34

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
