1 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 2 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 3 4 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 5 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 7 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 8 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

10 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 11 Assembly, that monies in The State Insurance Department Trust Fund are beyond what is needed to pay for the intended obligations of the fund; and that the 12 13 monies transferred to the Department of Human Services Grants Fund Account are needed to assist the state in its financial obligation to the Medicaid 14 15 Program due to the current economic crisis and increased usage in the 16 Medicaid Program; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is 17 essential to the operation of the agency for which the monies transferred by this Act provides, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular 18 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 19 20 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of 21 essential governmental programs.
