21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-42-104(d), concerning hunting and
24 fishing licenses for residents of this state age sixty five (65) and older,
25 is amended to read as follows:

26 (d)(1) The commission ~~may~~ shall provide for the issuance of a permanent
27 hunting or and fishing ~~licenses~~ license, ~~excluding the privileges covered by~~
28 ~~the migratory bird and trout permits with optional permanent trout stamp and~~
29 permanent state duck stamp, to a resident of this state who is sixty-five
30 (65) years of age or older ~~for fees not to exceed the cost of annual resident~~
31 licenses for a one-time fee of thirty-five dollars and fifty cents (\$35.50).

32 (2)(A) The commission shall provide for the issuance to a person
33 who, on the effective date of this subdivision (d)(2), holds a permanent
34 hunting and fishing license:

35 (i) A permanent trout stamp for a one-time fee of
36 five dollars (\$5.00);



1 (ii) A permanent state duck stamp for a one-time fee
2 of seven dollars (\$7.00); or

3 (iii) Both for a one-time fee of twelve dollars
4 (\$12.00).

5 (B) When a person purchases a permanent hunting and
6 fishing license under subdivision (d)(1) of this section, after the effective
7 date of this subdivision (d)(2), the commission shall provide the purchaser
8 with the following additional options:

9 (i) A permanent trout stamp for a one-time fee of
10 five dollars (\$5.00);

11 (ii) A permanent state duck stamp for a one-time fee
12 of seven dollars (\$7.00); or

13 (iii) Both for a one-time fee of twelve dollars
14 (\$12.00).

15 (3)(A) The commission may promulgate rules to establish
16 residency in Arkansas for purposes of this section (d).

17 (B) However, the rules shall not require more than three
18 (3) years residency in this state.
