16 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of 17 the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the 18 appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by Initiated Act 1 of 19 20 2000, the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative 21 Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of 22 Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the 23 official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 24 Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

26 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 28 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 31 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 32 33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 34 35 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 36
