AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC SERVICE
COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE
2003-2005 BIENNIUM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - UTILITIES DIVISION. There is hereby established for the Arkansas Public Service Commission - Utilities Division for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION. UTILITIES DIVISION. In the event of unforeseen conditions, additional appropriations become necessary that are not authorized or contemplated in ~~Section 3~~ the Utilities Division appropriation of this Act and such events make it necessary that the Public Service Commission - Utilities Division receives additional appropriations to carry out the objectives of the agency, the Director of the Public Service Commission is hereby authorized to request the approval of the Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, as hereinafter provided, for transfer of the additional appropriations provided in ~~Section 9~~ the Contingency appropriation to the appropriations provided by the Utilities Division appropriation ~~by Section 3~~, but in no event shall the transfers exceed the appropriations provided in the Contingency appropriation ~~Section 9~~ of this Act. Whenever the Director of the Public Service Commission deems it necessary to establish additional appropriations as authorized herein, he or she shall file with the Governor a written report accompanied by necessary supporting documents setting forth the facts, justifications, and circumstances that necessitate such appropriation. Upon receipt of such reports and supporting documents, the Governor, or his or her designee, shall study the same, and if he or she shall determine that such additional appropriations are being sought in strict compliance with this Act, the Governor, after seeking prior review and prior approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee, may approve or modify such request for additional appropriations as in his or her judgment he or she deems necessary, and shall forward a copy thereof to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Upon receipt thereof, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the State Auditor to process said transfer upon his books in accordance with the provisions as set out therein.

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Public Service Commission - Utilities Division may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Public Service Commission - Utilities Division authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 2003 through June 30, 2003 2005.

SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL RATES OF PAY. Due to the highly competitive job market conditions for utility rate case professionals and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Public Service Commission is authorized special rates of pay for current and new employees in the classification listed under subsection (a) below.

(b) A monthly report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council describing all personnel transactions involving applications of any of the provisions of this Section.

(c) Labor market rates will be established as needed for classifications not covered by the provisions of this section.

(d) A current plan of progression should be filed with the Office of Personnel Management on a biennial basis.

(e) This provision shall be in full force and effect for the biennium

beginning ~~July 1, 2001~~ July 1, 2003, and ending ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

~~The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.~~

SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. The Data Processing Services line item of the Utilities Division appropriation is to be used for the purpose of purchasing computer hardware, computer software, and technical services required for the installation, maintenance, and required training associated with the purchase of computer hardware and computer software. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized ~~in Item (09) of Section 3~~ by the Data Processing Services line item in the Utilities Division appropriation of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2002~~ 2004, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2003~~ 2005.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2001~~ 2003 through June 30, ~~2003~~ 2005.

SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized for Building Repairs/Maintenance in Item (06) of Section 3 of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending ~~June 30, 2002~~ June 30, 2004, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~ July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code Title 23, Chapter 2, Subchapter 1 is amended to add a new section to read as follows:
23-2-112. Rural and Community Liaison - General Job Responsibilities.
The Rural and Community Liaison will serve as a two-way communication link between the Arkansas Public Service Commission and utility customers in Arkansas, particularly those in rural areas. The Rural and Community Liaison is responsible for providing information to communities and rural utility

1 customers concerning utility matters within the jurisdiction of the
 2 Commission. The Rural and Community Liaison is also responsible for
 3 identifying questions and concerns that rural utility customers may have
 4 concerning utility issues and relaying those concerns to the Commissioners
 5 and the Commission Staff. In the performance of these duties, the Rural and
 6 Community Liaison will work with stakeholders in rural areas and communities,
 7 including legislators, civic and community leaders, customers and customer
 8 groups, and rural utility personnel.

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 10 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 12 CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION. TAX DIVISION. In the event additional
 13 appropriations become necessary that are not authorized or contemplated in

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
 12 2003 through June 30, 2003 2005.

 15 SECTION 16. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
 16 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES - PUBLIC
 17 SERVICE COMMISSION UTILITY SAFETY FUND AND TAX DIVISION FUND. (A) For all
 18 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
 19 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
 20 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause the Public Service
 21 Commission Utility Safety Fund to decline below four hundred sixteen thousand
 22 eight hundred thirty nine dollars (\$416,839) or the Tax Division Fund to
 23 decline below three hundred sixty six thousand five hundred forty four
 24 dollars (\$366,544) a fund balance to decline to less than fifty percent (50%)
 25 ~~of the balance available on July 1, 2001,~~ the disbursing officer shall
 26 immediately notify the executive head of the agency. Prior to any
 27 obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head shall file
 28 written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting
 29 approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient
 30 financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the following:
 31 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
 32 expenditures on the fund balance.
 33 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut
 34 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
 35 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
 36 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.

1 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
2 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
3 depletion of the fund balance.

4 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
5 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
6 prior review by the Legislative Council.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
8 through June 30, 2005.

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10 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
11 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
13 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

19
20 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
27 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
31 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
34 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
35 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
36 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

1 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
2 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
3 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
