1	SECTION 2. <u>Name change and merger.</u>
2	(a) Effective July 1, 2003, Garland County Community College is
3	renamed National Park Community College and the Garland County Community
4	College District is renamed The National Park Community College District.
5	(b) Effective July 1, 2003, Quapaw Technical Institute is merged with
6	and into National Park Community College.
7	(c) National Park Community College is an institution of higher
8	education, and is subject to the laws governing community colleges, except as
9	otherwise provided in this act.
10	
11	SECTION 3. Board of Trustees.
12	(a)(1) The board member of Quapaw Technical Institute serving on June
13	30, 2003, and whose term is to expire in 2003, shall become a member of the
14	board of trustees of National Park Community College on July 1, 2003, and the
15	term of the board member shall expire on December 31, 2004.
16	(2) The board members of the Quapaw Technical Institute serving
17	on June 30, 2003, and whose terms are to expire in 2004 and 2005, shall
18	become members of the board of trustees of National Park Community College on
19	July 1, 2003, and their terms shall expire on December 31, 2006.
20	(3) The board members of Quapaw Technical Institute serving on
21	June 30, 2003, and whose terms are to expire in 2006 and 2007, shall become
22	members of the board of trustees of National Park Community College on July
23	1, 2003, and their terms shall expire on December 31, 2008.
24	(b)(1) The trustees of the Garland County Community College serving on
25	June 30, 2003, and whose terms expire on December 31, 2004, shall become
26	members of the board of trustees of National Park Community College on July
27	1, 2003, and their terms shall expire on December 31, 2004.
28	(2) The trustees of the Garland County Community College serving
29	on June 30, 2003, and whose terms expire on December 31, 2006, shall become
30	members of the board of trustees of National Park Community College on July
31	1, 2003, and their terms shall expire on December 31, 2006.
32	(3) The trustees of the Garland County Community College serving
33	on June 30, 2003, and whose terms expire on December 31, 2008, shall become
34	members of the board of trustees of National Park Community College on July
35	1, 2003, and their terms shall expire on December 31, 2008.
36	(c)(1) Three (3) trustees of National Park Community College shall be

1	elected at the 2004 general election in the same manner and for the same
2	terms as prescribed in Arkansas Code § 6-61-520.
3	(2) Three (3) trustees of National Park Community College shall
4	be elected at the 2006 general election in the same manner and for the same
5	terms as prescribed in Arkansas Code § 6-61-520.
6	(3) Three (3) trustees of National Park Community College shall
7	be elected at the 2008 general election in the same manner and for the same
8	terms as prescribed in Arkansas Code § 6-61-520.
9	(d)(l) No vacancy on the Board of Trustees of National Park Community
10	College shall be filled until the number of remaining board members of
11	National Park Community College with terms expiring on the same date equals
12	two (2) or less.
13	(2) A vacancy on the board of Quapaw Technical Institute or on
14	the Board of Trustees of Garland County Community College occurring before
15	July 1, 2003 shall not be filled unless it would cause the Board of Trustees
16	of National Park Community College to have fewer than three (3) trustees
17	whose terms expire in the year 2004, 2006, or 2008.
18	
19	SECTION 4. Effect of merger on employees.
20	(a)(1) All permanent nonprobationary employees of Quapaw Technical
21	Institute or Garland County Community College on June 30, 2003, shall become
22	employees of National Park Community College on July 1, 2003.
23	(2) A person who was a permanent nonprobationary employee of
24	Quapaw Technical Institute or Garland County Community College on June 30,
25	2003, shall be employed by National Park Community College at least until
26	July 1, 2008, if:
27	(A) Job performance is satisfactory;
28	(B) Student enrollment in programs is satisfactory; and
29	(C) Student job placements are satisfactory.
30	(b)(1)(A) By January 31, 2004, employees who were employed on June 30,
31	2003, by Garland County Community College or Quapaw Technical Institute shall
32	have the right to make a one-time choice between:
33	(i) The National Park Community College health
34	insurance plan, which was formerly known as Garland County Community College
35	health insurance plan; or
36	(ii) The health insurance plan adopted by the State

1	and Public School Life and Health Insurance Board for state employees.
2	(B) An employee who was employed by Quapaw Technical
3	Institute on June 30, 2003, shall be entitled to remain in his or her same
4	retirement system under the same conditions then provided by law or as may
5	later be provided by law.
6	(2) The Board of Trustees of National Park Community College
7	shall promulgate rules and regulations establishing the procedure for
8	employees to exercise benefit options under this subsection (b).
9	(c)(l) Until the later of July 1, 2008, or the date a reorganization
10	that guarantees the importance and position of technical education is adopted
11	by the board of trustees of National Park Community College, the President of
12	the Quapaw Technical Institute as of June 30, 2003, shall be the Vice
13	President for Technical Education at National Park Community College.
14	(2) The employee who was the President of the Quapaw Technical
15	Institute as of June 30, 2003, shall retain and continue to receive:
16	(A) All options, rights, and benefits of employment
17	granted in subsection (b) of this section; and
18	(B) Any transportation benefits that accompanied the
19	position of President of the Quapaw Technical Institute.
20	(d) An employee who was a member of the faculty of Quapaw Technical
21	Institute on June 30, 2003, shall be deemed qualified to teach in the same
22	level programs at National Park Community College if:
23	(1) The faculty member's job performance is satisfactory;
24	(2) Student enrollment is satisfactory; and
25	(3) Student job placements are satisfactory.
26	
27	SECTION 5. <u>Sick leave.</u>
28	The employees of National Park Community College shall be entitled to
29	lump sum payment for unused sick leave under a program similar to that
30	authorized by Arkansas Code §§ 21-4-501 and 21-4-502.
31	
32	SECTION 6. <u>Catastrophic leave program.</u>
33	<u>National Park Community College shall establish a catastrophic leave</u>
34	program for all permanent employees. The program shall be similar to that
35	authorized under Arkansas Code § 21-4-214.
36	

1	SECTION 7. Effect of merger on curriculum.
2	(a)(1) National Park Community College shall offer the option of:
3	(A) Applied general education courses in occupational
4	certificate and associate degree programs now offered by Quapaw Technical
5	Institute; and
6	(B) Where appropriate to the program involved, programs
7	now offered by Garland County Community College.
8	(2) Students in the programs involved may also be offered the
9	options of college transfer general education courses in addition to the
10	option of applied general education courses.
11	(b) Without regard to the higher average cost of occupational
12	programs, all current Quapaw Technical Institute programs shall continue to
13	be offered by National Park Community College for as long as they meet
14	industry needs and are fiscally effective.
15	(c) All adult basic education, general educational development tests,
16	and high school programs currently provided by Quapaw Technical Institute or
17	the Garland County Community College shall continue at National Park
18	Community College.
19	(d) Existing certificate and degree programs now offered at Quapaw
20	Technical Institute or Garland County Community College shall continue to be
21	authorized for National Park Community College until the Arkansas Higher
22	Education Coordinating Board determines that the programs do not meet minimum
23	standards of quality and costeffectiveness.
24	
25	SECTION 8. <u>Purchasing</u> .
26	(a) Purchases by National Park Community College shall continue to be
27	made under procedures which were applicable to Garland County Community
28	College or may be made under procedures that were applicable to Quapaw
29	<u>Technical Institute.</u>
30	(b) Flexibility in shop purchases, parts, and house construction
31	programs shall continue in the same manner as authorized for the original
32	institutions.
33	
34	
	SECTION 9. <u>Transfer of assets, obligations, records, personnel,</u>
35	property, unexpended balances, and all legal authority.

1	of the Quapaw Technical Institute are transferred to National Park Community
2	<u>College.</u>
3	(b) On July 1, 2003, all obligations of the Quapaw Technical Institute
4	become obligations of National Park Community College.
5	(c) On July 1, 2003, all records, personnel, property, unexpended
6	balances of appropriations and funds, and all legal authority will transfer
7	from the Quapaw Technical Institute to National Park Community College.
8	(d) All cash fund balances of Quapaw Technical Institute transferred
9	to National Park Community College shall be used for the operation, support,
10	and improvement of occupational, vocational, technical, and workforce
11	development programs of National Park Community College.
12	
13	SECTION 10. Workforce 2000 funding.
14	Funding from the Workforce 2000 Development Fund which would have been
15	provided to Quapaw Technical Institute shall be provided to National Park
16	Community College to fund workforce development, vocational, occupational,
17	and training programs offered by National Park Community College.
18	
19	Section 11. Funding for salary equity.
20	In that funding for and achievement of salary equity among employees of
21	National Park Community College is essential for the successful merger of
22	Quapaw Technical Institute into National Park Community College, this act
23	shall become void if the board of either Garland County Community College or
24	Quapaw Technical Institute, prior to May 1, 2003, determines that funds are
25	not available to achieve salary equity.
26	
27	SECTION 12. Conversion of positions and maximum salaries for Quapaw
28	Technical Institute.
29	The maximum salaries as authorized for the positions in the
30	appropriation act for Quapaw Technical Institute shall be converted to the
31	maximum salaries for the equivalent or similar positions as authorized in the
32	appropriation act for Garland County Community College. The conversion of
33	the maximum salaries shall be approved by the Department of Higher Education
34	for line item salaries or by the Department of Finance and Administration for
35	classified salaries, and be reported to the Legislative Council.
36	

1	SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
2	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Garland County Community
3	College should be renamed as National Park Community College; that it would
4	benefit both Quapaw Technical Institute and National Park Community College
5	to merge into one institution; that the merger of Quapaw Technical Institute
6	into National Park Community College should occur at the beginning of the
7	next fiscal year; that substantial work must be done before the merger; and
8	that this act is immediately necessary in order for the preparatory work for
9	the merger to be completed. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and
10	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
11	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
12	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
13	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
14	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
15	bill; or
16	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
17	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
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
