17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
18

19 SECTION 1. (a) Any person who violates the conditions of a no contact  
20 order issued under Arkansas Code § 5-4-303(c)(6) or Rule 9.3 of the Arkansas  
21 Rules of Criminal Procedure is guilty of violation of a no contact order.

22 (b) A no contact order issued under Arkansas Code § 5-4-303(c)(6) or  
23 Rule 9.3 Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure is an offense one (1)  
24 classification lower than the offense for which the no contact order was  
25 issued.

26 (c) Nothing in this act shall be deemed to prevent a judicial officer  
27 from taking any action authorized under Arkansas Code § 5-4-303 or Rule 9.3  
28 of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure.
