Subtitle AN ACT TO SUBJECT AN OFFENDER TO AN ENHANCED PENALTY FOR MANUFACTURING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE NEAR CERTAIN FACILITIES.


## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-64-411(a), concerning selling controlled substances near certain facilities, is amended to read as follows:
(a) Any person who commits an offense under § 5-64-401(a) by selling, delivering, possessing with intent to deliver, dispensing, manufacturing, transporting, administering, or distributing a controlled substance may be subject to an enhanced sentence of an additional term of imprisonment of ten (10) years if the offense is committed on or within one thousand feet ( $1,000^{\prime}$ ) of the real property of:
(1) A city or state park;
(2) A public or private elementary or secondary school, public vocational school, or private or public college or university;
(3) A skating rink, Boys Club, Girls Club, YMCA, YWCA, or community or recreation center;
(4) A publicly funded and administered multifamily housing development;
(5) A drug or alcohol treatment facility;
(6) A day care center; or
(7) A church.
