9 AN ACT TO SUBJECT AN OFFENDER TO AN ENHANCED  
10 PENALTY FOR MANUFACTURING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE  
11 NEAR CERTAIN FACILITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-64-411(a), concerning selling controlled  
23 substances near certain facilities, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a) Any person who commits an offense under § 5-64-401(a) by selling,  
25 delivering, possessing with intent to deliver, dispensing, manufacturing,  
26 transporting, administering, or distributing a controlled substance may be  
27 subject to an enhanced sentence of an additional term of imprisonment of ten  
28 (10) years if the offense is committed on or within one thousand feet (1,000')  
29 of the real property of:

30 (1) A city or state park;

31 (2) A public or private elementary or secondary school, public  
32 vocational school, or private or public college or university;

33 (3) A skating rink, Boys Club, Girls Club, YMCA, YWCA, or  
34 community or recreation center;

35 (4) A publicly funded and administered multifamily housing  
36 development;

- 2 (6) A day care center; or
- 3 (7) A church.
