- 17 <u>following conditions and restrictions:</u>
- 18 <u>(1) by appropriation therefrom by the General Assembly; or</u>
- 19 (2) a "revenue shortfall" exists as defined as a circumstance when the
- 20 official general revenue projection certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
- 21 the State and in effect on July 1 of the current fiscal year is required to
- 22 be reduced by at least five percent (5%) due to changes in economic
- 23 conditions; or
- 24 (3) a "federal/court mandate" exists as defined as a circumstance when
- 25 <u>mandates or specific requirements of the federal government or federal courts</u>
- 26 require an increase in the general revenues available to a fund or fund
- 27 account above the amount certified for the fund or fund account by the Chief
- 28 Fiscal Officer of the State on July 1 of the current fiscal year and the
- 29 required increase in the current fiscal year on an annual basis is ten
- 30 percent (10%) or more.
- 31 (e) In the event that the Governor or the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
- 32 or both determine that circumstances exist that meet the requirements for the
- 33 utilization of the Rainy Day Fund as set out in (d)(1) or (d)(2) of this
