33	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
34		
35	SECTION 1. This act shall not affect the terms of members of the	
36	Oversight Committee on Prostate and Testicular Cancer serving on the	

1	effective date of this act.
2	
3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-15-1603(a), concerning membership
4	of the Oversight Committee on Prostate and Testicular Cancer, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	(a) The Oversight Committee on Prostate and Testicular Cancer is
7	created and shall be composed of seven (7) members as follows:
8	(1) One (1) individual from the private medical community who
9	shall be a practicing urologist, a practicing radiation therapist, or a
10	practicing medical oncologist;
11	(2) One (1) faculty member from the Arkansas Cancer Research
12	Center of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences;
13	(3) One (1) representative from the American Cancer Society;
14	(4) One (1) public health educator;
15	(5) The Director of the Department of Health or the director's
16	designee; and
17	(6) Two (2) men's advocates, one (1) of whom shall be $\frac{a}{a}$
18	African-American survivor of prostate or testicular cancer and one (1) of
19	whom shall be a representative of the Arkansas Prostate Cancer Foundation.
20	
21	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-15-1604, concerning the powers and
22	duties of the Oversight Committee on Prostate and Testicular Cancer, is
23	amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
24	(f) The Arkansas Minority Health Commission shall support the work of
25	the commission by:
26	(1) Providing education and awareness programs;
27	(2) Supporting research;
28	(3) Supporting screening programs; and
29	(4) Distributing information on the prevention, treatment, and
30	detection of prostate and testicular cancer in the male population of
31	Arkansas.
