11 DUTY-FREE LUNCH PERIODS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 22 is
22 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 6-22-2205. Duty-free lunch period.

24 For a minimum of eighty percent (80%) of the employees work days, each
25 school district in this state shall provide:

26 (1) No less than one (1) thirty (30) minute paid, uninterrupted,
27 and duty-free lunch period for each classified school employee in its
28 employment;

29 (2) Each school district in the state shall provide no less than
30 two (2) paid, fifteen (15) minute breaks during each regular work day for
31 each certified school employee.
