14	(a) All nursing facilities required to have nurses aides and
15	participation in the state Medicaid program shall require all nurses aides

17	(1) Complete two (2) hours of orientation, which shall be
18	specific to the facility in which the nurse aide is employed, and including
19	the Heimlich maneuver; and
20	(2) Satisfy one (1) of the following:
21	(A) Complete a state-approved training and competency
22	evaluation program; or
23	(B) Demonstrate competence through satisfactory
24	participating in a state-approved nurses aide training and competency
25	evaluation program that includes at least sixteen (16) hours of training in
