- The Cabot Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000) thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), as may be determined by the governing body of the City of Cabot.
- The Camden Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), to be paid by the City of Camden and Ouachita County.
- The Carlisle Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) nor more than nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000).
- The Charleston Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000).
