Arkansas Code § 16-17-108 is amended to read as follows: 23 16-17-108. Salaries of personnel and other requirements of various 24 municipal district courts. 25 (a) The Alexander Municipal District Court Judge shall receive a 26 monthly salary of not more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). (b) The Arkadelphia-Clark County Municipal District Court Judge shall 27 receive an annual salary of not less than fifty-three thousand five hundred 28 29 dollars (\$53,500) nor more than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), and the Arkadelphia-Clark County Municipal District Court Clerk shall receive an 30 31 annual salary of not less than twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) nor 32 more than twenty-nine thousand one hundred twenty dollars (\$29,120), such 33 salaries to be established annually by the Clark County Quorum Court. Upon approval by the Clark County Quorum Court, the Arkadelphia-Clark County 34 35 Municipal District Court Judge may appoint one (1) deputy municipal district clerk to receive a salary as established by the Clark County Quorum Court. 36

The Ashdown Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) thirty-two thousand eight hundred (\$32,800) nor more than forty-four thousand dollars (\$44,000), as determined by the governing body of the City of Ashdown and the Quorum Court of Little River County. The salary shall be paid sixty-two percent (62%) by Little River County and thirty-eight percent (38%) by the City of Ashdown, unless otherwise agreed by the Quorum Court of Little River County and the governing body of the City of Ashdown.

- (d) The Ash Flat Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), and the Ash Flat Municipal District Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000), as determined by the Quorum Court of Sharp County and to be paid by Sharp County.
- (e) The Augusta Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), the city and the county to share the cost equally.
- The Batesville Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-six thousand four hundred dollars (\$26,400) thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than thirty-eight thousand seven hundred twenty (\$38,720) forty-three thousand dollars (\$43,000), as determined by the governing body of Batesville and the Quorum Court of Independence County.
- The Beebe Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual 27 salary of not less than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) twenty-four thousand nine hundred eighty dollars (\$24,980) nor more than twenty seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$27,500) thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000). The municipal district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less 31 than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) twenty-four thousand four hundred dollars (\$24,400) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) thirty 33 thousand dollars (\$30,000).
  - (h) The Benton Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) nor more than ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) ninety-nine

thousand dollars (\$99,000), and the court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than forty thousand dollars (\$40,000). Such salaries shall be as determined by the governing body of the City of Benton and the Saline County Quorum Court.

- (i) The Benton County <u>Municipal District</u> Court-West Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) and not more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), as determined by the Benton County Quorum Court and the governing bodies of the City of Gentry and the City of Decatur. One-half (1/2) of the salary is to be paid by Benton County, one-fourth (1/4) of the salary is to be paid by the City of Decatur, and one-fourth (1/4) of the salary is to be paid by the City of Gentry.
- (j) The Bentonville <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) nor more than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), as determined by the City Council of Bentonville in concurrence with the Benton County Quorum Court.
- (k) The Berryville <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) and not more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000).
- (1) The Biscoe <u>Municipal District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than three thousand six hundred dollars (\$3,600) nor more than thirteen thousand six hundred dollars (\$13,600).
- (m) The Blytheville <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than <u>forty thousand dollars (\$40,000)</u> <u>forty-five</u> <u>thousand dollars (\$45,000)</u> nor more than <u>fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000)</u>, <u>seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000)</u> as may be approved by the Mississippi County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Blytheville.
- (n) The Booneville <u>Municipal District</u> Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) nor more than forty thousand dollars (\$40,000), as may be determined by the City Council of the City of Booneville and the Quorum Court of Logan County and shall be payable one-half (1/2) by the City of Booneville and one-half (1/2) by Logan County and shall be paid in twelve (12) equal monthly installments.
- (o) The Bradley County <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) as established by the Bradley

1 County Quorum Court and approved by the governing body of the City of Warren.

- 2 (p) The Brinkley <u>Municipal District</u> Court Judge shall receive an
  3 annual salary of not less than ten thousand two hundred dollars (\$10,200) nor
  4 more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), and the Brinkley <u>Municipal</u>
  5 <u>District</u> Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten
  6 thousand four hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$10,488) and not more than twenty
  7 thousand dollars (\$20,000).
  - (q) The Bryant <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than <u>thirty-nine thousand five hundred dollars</u> (\$39,500) <u>fifty thousand dollars</u> (\$50,000).

- (r) The Cabot <u>Municipal District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000) thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), as may be determined by the governing body of the City of Cabot.
- (s) The Camden <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), to be paid by the City of Camden and Ouachita County.
- (t) The Carlisle <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) nor more than nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000).
- (u) The Charleston <u>Municipal District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than <u>sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000)</u> eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000). The salaries and costs may be set and the payment thereof may be apportioned by agreement between the governing body of the City of Charleston and the Franklin County Quorum Court.
- (v) The Clarendon <u>Municipal District</u> Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand eight hundred dollars (\$4,800), and the Clarendon <u>Municipal District</u> Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than eight thousand nine hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$8,988).
- 34 (w) The Clarksville <u>Municipal District</u> Court Judge shall receive an 35 annual salary of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) nor 36 more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000). This expense, as well as all

other expenses related to the operation of the Clarksville Municipal District

- 2 Court, is to be divided among the county and all cities within the county
- 3 based on the percentage of the total fine money collected during the year by
- 4 each participating entity.
- 5 (x) The Clinton-Van Buren County <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall
- 6 receive an annual salary of not less than eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000)
- 7 nor more than thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000), as determined by the
- 8 City Council of Clinton and the Quorum Court of Van Buren County. This salary
- 9 and that of the clerk and any deputies shall be apportioned between the

- 20 (B) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed

- 24 (2)(A) The clerks of the respective municipal district courts

- 29 (B) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed

- 31 (aa)(1) The Judge of the Municipal District Court of Craighead County
- 32 shall be a full-time municipal district judge and shall receive as
- 33 compensation for services an annual salary of not less than seventy-nine
- 34 thousand nine hundred dollars (\$79,900) nor more than eighty-seven thousand
- 35 dollars (\$87,000), as determined by the Quorum Court of Craighead County and
- 36 the governing body of the City of Jonesboro, to be paid in equal monthly

- 1 installments. The amount of the salary shall be appropriated by ordinance
- 2 adopted by the Quorum Court of Craighead County. The amount of the salary and
- 3 necessary expenses appropriated for the court shall be apportioned among and
- 4 paid to the county from the respective cities of the first class and cities
- 5 of the second class, incorporated towns, and the government of Craighead
- 6 County as a prorated amount based on the number of cases filed from each of
- 7 the towns and cities and the county during the preceding calendar year.
- 8 Apportionment of the costs of the court shall be by order of the Municipal
- 9 District court upon certification of the cases filed by the Clerk of the

- 11 (2) The Judge of the Municipal District Court of Craighead
- 12 County shall maintain dockets and hold court, as deemed necessary, in each of
- 13 the county seats of Craighead County and may establish dockets and hold court
- 14 in other cities and towns in Craighead County as deemed necessary by
- ordinance adopted by the Quorum Court of Craighead County.
- 16 (bb) The Crossett <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an
- 17 annual salary of not less than ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800)
- 18 nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the municipal
- 19 district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven
- 20 thousand dollars (\$7,000) nor more than nineteen thousand five hundred
- 21 dollars (\$19,500). The salaries shall be in an amount within the range
- 22 prescribed in this subsection, as agreed upon by the Ashley County Quorum
- 23 Court and the governing body of the City of Crossett.
- 24 (cc) The DeQueen <u>Municipal</u> <u>District</u> Court Judge shall receive an
- 25 annual salary of not less than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) nor more
- 26 than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000). The DeQueen Municipal District
- 27 Court Clerk shall have an annual salary of not less than fourteen thousand
- 28 dollars (\$14,000). The salaries, expenses, and operating costs of the
- 29 Municipal District Court of the City of DeQueen shall be paid equally by the
- 30 City of DeQueen and the County of Sevier.
