22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 120, Subchapter 1 is
25 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 16-120-105. Donors of fire fighting equipment not liable - Exception.

27 (a) As used in this section:

28 (1) "Donor department" means any fire department in Arkansas,
29 including a volunteer fire department, a fire protection district, a
30 municipal fire department, or a fire department for a suburban improvement
31 district or a subordinate service district of a county;

32 (2) "Fire fighting equipment" means any personal property owned
33 by a donor department that is used for fire fighting services or training,
34 emergency medical services, or rescue services.
