2	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the				
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Insurance Fraud				
4	Investigation Division of the State Insurance Department needs to recruit and				
5	retain attorneys to act as appointed special deputy prosecuting attorneys;				
6	that the division is unable to recruit and retain attorneys due to the lower				
7	pay rates under current Arkansas law and the highly competitive salaries paid				
8	to elected prosecuting attorneys throughout the state; and that this act is				
9	immediately necessary to enable the division to recruit and retain attorneys				
10	by offering more competitive salaries. Therefore, an emergency is declared				
11	to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the				
12	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:				
13	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;				
14	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,				
15	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the				
16	bill; or				
17	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is				
18	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.				
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
