## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 182 OF 2003 TO DEFINE “SYSTEM  
11 SOFTWARE”, “APPLICATION SOFTWARE”, AND “SYSTEM  
12 SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE”; TO ALLOW A SALES OR USE  
13 TAX CREDIT ON THE PURCHASE OR LICENSE OF SYSTEM  
14 SOFTWARE OR SYSTEM SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE FOR A  
15 QUALIFIED COMPUTER-RELATED BUSINESS; AND FOR  
16 OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

18 TO AMEND ACT 182 OF 2003 REGARDING  
19 COMPUTER SOFTWARE, APPLICATION SOFTWARE,  
20 AND SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2703, as amended by Act 182 of 2003,*  
27 *is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:*

28 (39)(1) “Application software” means the programming system or  
29 technical language designed either for application in a specialized use or  
30 upon which, or by means of which, a plan for the solution of a particular  
31 problem is based.

32 (2) “Application software” can typically be transferred  
33 from one computer to another.

34 (3) Examples of application software include:

35 (A) Payroll processing;

36 (B) General ledger;

1 (C) Sales management;

2 (D) Spreadsheets; and

3 (E) Word processing.

4 (40) "System software" means:

5 (A) All of the software used to operate, maintain, and  
6 manage a computer system, including the operating system, utility programs,  
7 and other programs that help to operate, maintain, and manage one (1) or more  
8 resources on a computer system; and

9 (B) Programs used to analyze, organize, sort, correlate,  
10 format, standardize, cleanse, or correct data that is being prepared,  
11 organized, or stored for use by application programs.

12 (41) "System software maintenance" means any, all, or a  
13 combination of the following:

14 (A) Technical consultation or support service provided by  
15 telephone or onsite visits;

16 (B) Corrections of errors, malfunctions, or bugs in the  
17 system software;

18 (C) Provisions for enhancement of, or upgrades to, the  
19 system software;

20 (D) Revisions to operating manuals for the system  
21 software; or

22 (E) Training services.

23  
24 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2706(d)(2), as amended by Act 182 of  
25 2003, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

26 (C)(i)(a) A sales or use tax refund on the purchase or  
27 license of system software or system software maintenance for a qualified  
28 computer-related business shall be authorized by the Director of the  
29 Department of Finance and Administration.

30 (b) A refund of sales and use taxes imposed by  
31 a municipality or county shall be allowed if the municipality or county has  
32 authorized the refund in an endorsement resolution that was submitted along  
33 with the application to the Department of Economic Development.

34 (c) Sales tax refunds shall not be available  
35 for application software.

36 (ii) "Qualified computer-related business" means a

1 business that has an annual payroll of over five million dollars (\$5,000,000)  
2 and pays average hourly wages that exceed one hundred fifty percent (150%) of  
3 the county average wage in which the business is located.
