## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REVISE THE HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR  
CONDITIONING, AND REFRIGERATION LICENSING LAW TO  
CHANGE THE GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REVISE THE HVACR LICENSING LAW TO  
CHANGE THE GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE  
COVERAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code is amended to read as follows:  
17-33-302. Qualifications.

(a) An applicant for an HVACR license must meet the following minimum requirements:

(1) The applicant must be an individual of at least eighteen (18) years of age;

(2) The applicant must make application to the department on forms prescribed by the HVACR Licensing Board;

(3) The applicant must specify the class of license desired;

(4) The applicant must meet all requirements specified by rule and regulation promulgated by the board;

(5) The applicant must pay the appropriate examination and license fees required by the board; ~~and~~

(6) The applicant must pass the appropriate examinations



1 specified by the board~~r~~; and

2 (7) The applicant shall provide to the board proof of a minimum  
3 of general liability insurance coverage in the amount of:

4 (A) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for Class D, E,  
5 and L licensees; and

6 (B) Two hundred fifty thousand dollars for Class A,  
7 B, and C licensees.

8 (b) An applicant who fails an examination is eligible for  
9 reexamination.
