## Subtitle

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15 AN ACT TO EXEMPT EAST ARKANSAS COMMUNITY  
16 COLLEGE FROM REVIEW AND APPROVAL BY  
17 ARKANSAS BUILDING SERVICES FOR PROJECTS  
18 EXCEEDING FIVE MILLION DOLLARS  
19 (\$5,000,000).

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-1415(b), concerning exemptions to the  
25 procedures for projects exceeding five million dollars (\$5,000,000), is  
26 amended to read as follows:

27 (b)(1) No contract for projects between the state agency and the  
28 construction manager, general contractor, architect, or engineer shall be  
29 entered into without first obtaining approval of Arkansas State Building  
30 Services and review by the Legislative Council.

31 (2) Arkansas State Building Services shall have involvement in  
32 the selection and contract process from the project inception.

33 (3) There shall be separate contracts for design and  
34 construction services.

35 (4) Arkansas State Building Services shall have the authority to  
36 promulgate rules and regulations pertaining to the process for awarding and



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1 overseeing the contracts.

2 (5) The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas ~~and~~ ,  
3 the Board of Trustees of Arkansas State University, and the Board of Trustees  
4 of East Arkansas Community College shall be exempt from review and approval  
5 by Arkansas State Building Services and any regulations promulgated by it,  
6 provided that the institutions shall have adopted policies and procedures  
7 involving the awarding and oversight of the contracts for design and  
8 construction services.

9 (6) All procedures pertaining to the contracts shall provide, to  
10 the extent practicable, substantial uniformity between these institutions  
11 with respect to the policies and procedures to be followed.

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
