(B)(i) If the three-wheeled or four-wheeled all-terrain cycle was manufactured on or before December 31, 1992, then proof of ownership shall not be required to obtain registration, and a statement of ownership shall be <u>accepted as proof of ownership</u>. (ii) The statement of ownership may be prepared by the person and shall contain the following information: (a) The person's name; (b) A description of the cycle; (c) A statement that the cycle was manufactured on or before December 31, 1992; (d) A statement of ownership; and (e) The person's signature. The cost of registration shall be five dollars (\$5.00). (c)
