17 TO *ALLOW* STATE FUNDED COLLEGES AND
18 UNIVERSITIES TO WAIVE UP TO TWENTY-FIVE
19 PERCENT (25%) OF TUITION COSTS FOR
20 ARKANSAS ARMY AND AIR NATIONAL GUARD.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 Section 1. (a) Colleges, universities, community colleges, technical
26 schools, and other post-secondary institutions of higher learning located in
27 the State of Arkansas that directly receive funds appropriated by the General
28 Assembly may waive up to twenty-five percent (25%) of the tuition at the
29 institution for soldiers and airmen of the Arkansas National Guard who are
30 participants in the Arkansas National Guard Tuition Assistance Plan.

31 (b) The Arkansas National Guard Tuition Assistance Plan shall fund the
32 first seventy-five percent (75%) of all the tuition costs for the soldiers
33 and airmen.

34 (c)(1) The Adjutant General for Arkansas shall establish and publish
35 regulations for the eligibility and implementation of the Arkansas National
36 Guard Tuition Assistance Plan.
