SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 26-57-1106(a)(2), concerning distribution of funds for breast cancer research and control, is amended to read as follows: (2) Eighty percent (80%) shall be credited to the Breast Cancer Control Fund, which is hereby created on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to be used exclusively for the purposes set forth in § 20-15-1304 and at the option of the Department of Health University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in an amount not to exceed the amount appropriated by the General Assembly for the purpose of cervical cancer control. The Director of the Department of Health shall be the disbursing officer for the Breast Cancer Control Fund, and the The Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall be the disbursing officer for the Breast Cancer Research Fund and the Breast Cancer Control Fund.
