26	15-22-905. Powers of commission — Limitations.			
27	The following provisions shall limit the Arkansas Soil and Water			
28	Conservation Commission's powers under this subchapter:			
29	$(1)(\Lambda)$ There will be no reduction or limitation of the withdrawal of			
30	groundwater from exist	groundwater from existing wells in an alluvial aquifer for which a water		
31	right is grandfathered under the provisions of § 15-22-910(a)(1) unless			
32	alternative surface supplies are available or can be made available at a cost			
33	to the person no greater than the operating cost of the person's wells within			
34	the critical area, including depreciation costs over the life of the well.			
35	(B) There shall be no reduction or limitation of the withdrawal			
36	of groundwater from existing wells in a sustaining aquifer for which a water			

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1 right is grandfathered under the provisions of § 15-22-910(a)(1) unless 2 alternative surface supplies are available; $\frac{(2)}{(1)}$ (1)(A) In an alluvial aquifer, there will be no reduction or 3 4 limitation of the withdrawal of groundwater from wells for which a water 5 right has been issued under § 15-22-910 and for which the person holding the 6 right can demonstrate: 7 (i) A reduction of twenty percent (20%) of his or her use 8 of groundwater by either institution of water conservation measures or 9 conversion to surface supplies. The demonstrated reduction must be based on 10 the use reported in water year 1986 or later; or 11 (ii) The implementation of a water conservation plan 12 employing generally accepted water conservation practices approved by the 13 commission. (B) In sustaining aquifers, the Arkansas Soil and Water 14 15 Conservation Commission may consider voluntary reductions, water use 16 efficiencies, and implementation of water conservation measures in 17 determining limitations or reduction of withdrawals; 18 (3)(2) There will be no regulation of the withdrawal of groundwater 19 from existing or proposed wells which have a maximum potential flow rate of less than fifty thousand (50,000) gallons per day; 20 21 (4)(3) There shall be no regulation of the withdrawals of groundwater 22 from individual household wells used exclusively for domestic use; 23 (5)(4) Replacement wells: 24 (A)(i) The owner of an existing well may construct a replacement 25 well after abandoning the existing well. 26 (ii) To transfer a water right to a replacement well the 27 owner need only submit to the commission notice of construction of a 28 replacement well stating the location and ownership of the original and 29 replacement wells and other relevant information required by the commission. 30 (B) The original well must be converted to a nonregulated use or 31 plugged in the manner prescribed by the commission; and 32 (6)(5) Marketers of bottled water, public utility electric generating 33 plants, and public water supply systems shall at no time be restricted in the 34 place of use of groundwater. 35
