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1 (1) Fourteen percent (14%) Seven percent (7%) of the revenues 2 derived from this fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury as special 3 revenues and credited to the Public Health Fund to be used exclusively for 4 the Office of Alcohol Testing of the Department of Health;
