AN ACT TO DENY PERSONS CONVICTED OF SECOND DEGREE
MURDER FROM ANY WORK RELEASE PROGRAM; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

AN ACT TO DENY PERSONS CONVICTED OF
SECOND DEGREE MURDER FROM ANY WORK
RELEASE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-30-404 is amended to read as follows:
12-30-404. Inmates excepted from program.

(a) No person convicted of a capital offense, murder in the first degree, § 5-10-102, murder in the second degree, § 5-10-103, rape, § 5-14-103, or kidnapping, § 5-11-102, or a person convicted for the second or subsequent time of aggravated robbery, § 5-12-103, shall be allowed to participate in any work-release program conducted by or for the Department of Correction.

(b) However, this section shall not apply to persons participating in work-release programs on July 20, 1979.
